

As we near the end of this unprecedented and challenging year, we want to thank you for your continued support of Education at Elevation.

Many of us have found our lives radically altered this year, with our calendars suddenly bare, a myriad of technological challenges to contend with, and the urgent daily need to figure out how to keep ourselves and others safe and healthy. For the children we support in Tibet, the challenges are different. Up on the Tibetan High Plateau, life at the school looks much as it always has on a daily basis. The remoteness of the village makes traveling there difficult, and has helped to keep the virus away. Fortunately, the school has remained open, with no cases of Covid at the school itself or in the village of Baiyu. Our students continue to spend their days learning mathematics, reading and writing in Tibetan and Mandarin, and doing important Tibetan cultural activities. For this, we're so thankful.

For those who are fortunate enough to have maintained their income during the pandemic, it's more important than ever before to offer support to those who have less. If you've chosen to support Education at Elevation this year, we want you to know that your support makes a difference. The budget and donation income estimates have been conservative since we do not know how much and how long the pandemic will affect us at the time the budget is passed at Annual General Meeting on November 2020.



News from school

- **Quarantine by default!**
The kids and the teachers are all healthy this year as reported by Sonam Rinpoche. Thanks to the school's remote location, the kids have continued to study and stay in the school since they already in quarantine by default.
- **Exciting move to new school building!**
After three years of construction, the students and teachers have finally moved to the new building at the beginning of the new school year in September 2020. The school opening ceremony that was planned for summer this year has been cancelled due to the pandemic. This would have been a great memorable moment for Sonam Rinpoche, to witness the kids begin their new school year in the new building, but safety was more important. We could not have come so far without your generous supports all these years. We sincerely **THANK YOU** from the bottom of our hearts.

- Tibetan young women scholarship abruptly terminated this year!
For many years, E@E has sponsored scholarships for two young women through the collaboration with Tibetan Village Project (TVP). Due to a new law that came into effect on foreign NGOs in 2017 in China, more than 90% of local NGOs are no longer operating in Tibet (<https://www.tamdinwangdu.com>). As a result, TVP has dissolved both of its organizations in China and USA in 2020.

E@E will continue to look for alternative ways to sponsor the education of young women in Tibet or other high elevation countries.


Last year's photos

Karma Kookies Spring Bake Fundraiser Result




Every bite counts!


